



REQUIREMENTS FOR GOVERNMENT GRATUITOUS PERMIT APPLICATION

1. Letter of intent address to Provincial Governor thru the Provincial Mining Regulatory Board (PMRB);
2. Application form duly accomplished;
3. Sketch Plan of the area applied, signed by licensed Deputized Geodetic Engineer;
4. Area Status Clearance;
5. Certification from City/Municipal Engineer stating necessity of the proposed projects where the materials are to be utilized;
6. Certification of the LGU-Budget Officer that there is no fund allocation for the projects;
7. Recommendation from the Municipal Mayor if the applicant is LGU-Barangay;
8. Recommendation from the Sangguniang Bayan if the applicant is the Municipal Mayor;
9. Clearance from the concern agency whose project may be affected by the propose quarry activity;
10. Clearance/consent from the lot owner if the applied area is within private property;
11. Certification from the Municipal Assessor that the area applied is free from any encumbrances if it is within private property;
12. Quarrying Development and Environmental Management Plan, (can be made by DPWH Engineer);
13. Program of work;
14. Clearance from Environmental Management Bureau, ECC or CNC, (optional); and

Note:

Maximum area allowed is two (2) hectares and coterminous upon completion of the project but not to exceed one (1) year.
